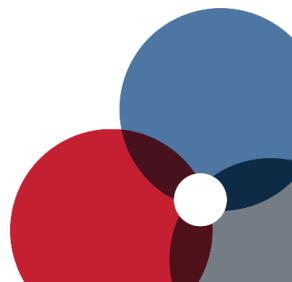

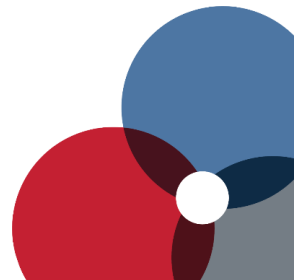
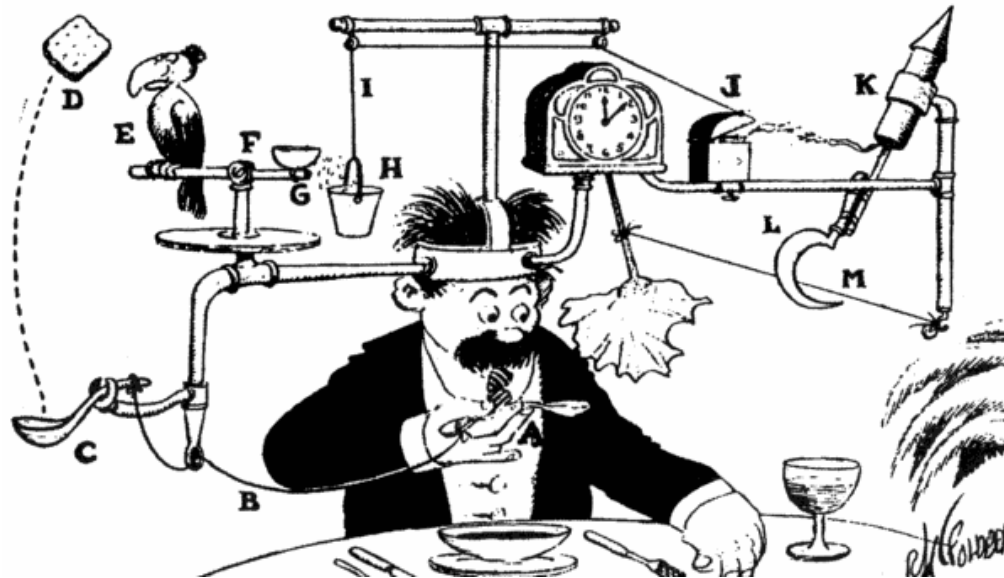

1 in 2 low-income individuals



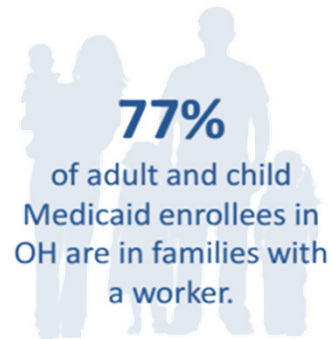
2 in 5 children



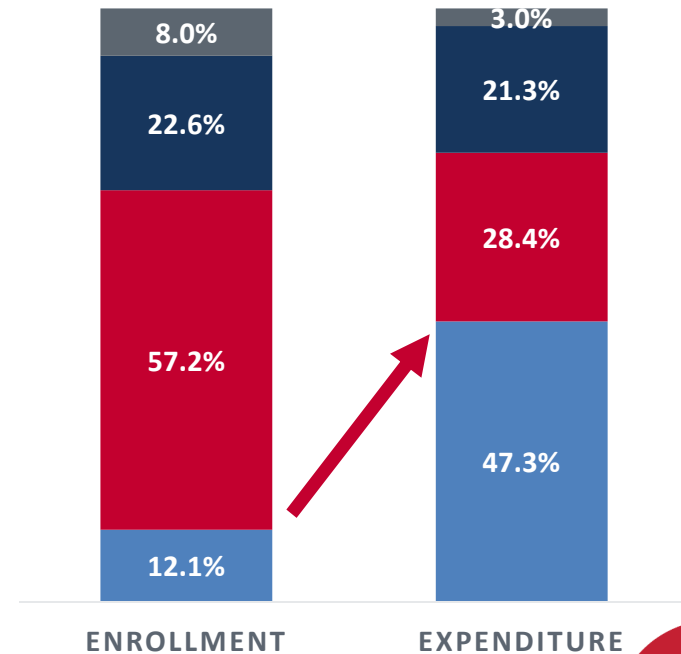
3 in 5 nursing home residents



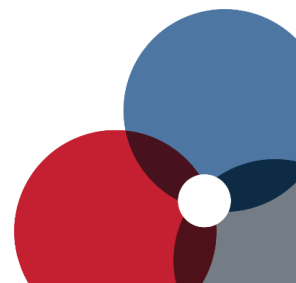
1 in 2 people with disabilities

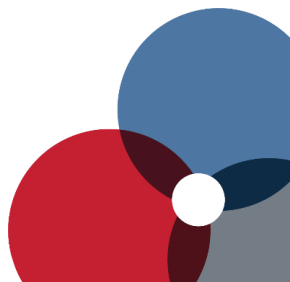

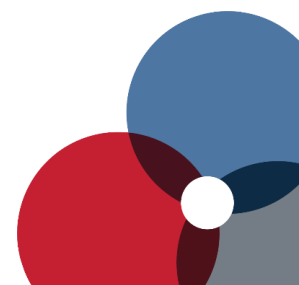

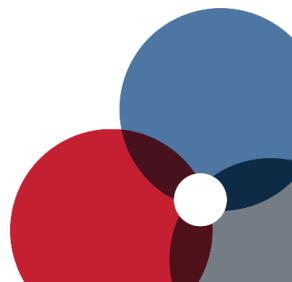
